

## Environmental Education Programming

#### **Exploring the Seasons (K-1)**

No matter what the season, there is always something to explore in the natural world. Find out what creatures you would find, how they adapt to the season and what part of their lifecycle you would be likely to find at that time of year.

#### Stages of Life (Grade 2+)

Explore the stages of insect life in your neighbourhood. Choose from insects of the water (pond), soil (compost) or land.



#### Bioblitz (Grade 3+)

Learn to identify plants and animals based on observable features. Learn how the creatures interact with each other. Create a list of all species observed in a specific location and submit your list to iNaturalist app/website to share with the world.

#### Recyclogic (Grade 5+)

Explore the effects of consumerism on people and places. Learn how to make trash into treasures and find out tips and tricks for frugal, eco-friendly living.

# Christian Faith & the Environment (Grade 7+)

Discover what the Bible has to say about how we should interact with the earth and what Christians around the world are doing to be stewards of the parts of creation God has gifted to them.

#### Nature Walk (all ages)

You never know what you will see in nature on any given walk. Perfect for when you have out of town visitors and want to show them the sights. Themed walks available including bird watching, salmon trails, and more.



#### The Story of Salmon
