NESTBOX EVIDENCE STEWARDSHIP TRAINING

Help provide essential habitat for breeding birds at risk in Southern Ontario!

We are seeking volunteers to put up one of our nest boxes on their property and support monitoring. We will provide and install the nest boxes, train you to monitor them and support you throughout the process.

These nest boxes will support biodiversity by providing increased nesting habitat to support the population growth of at-risk species.

Eligibility

To participate, you must have a property located in this area.

As well, your property should have habitat of the following:

- streams, rivers, ponds, or lakes;
- forest, woodlots, or hedgerows; or
- meadows or grassland.

If you are unsure if this applies to your property, please reach out to us.

Participants will be given training in species identification and monitoring practices. You will also be expected to send A Rocha Ontario regular updates from data collected from the nest box(es).

Record and share observations with A Rocha Ontario, using the Nest Watch Data Form that we will train you to use.
