JOB DESCRIPTION

About the WildRoots Program

WildRoots is A Rocha Manitoba's 16-week paid summer work program designed for young adults who care about climate change and nature conservation. Through hands-on work, learning, mentorship, and community rhythms, participants are invited into a way of life in which creation care is woven into daily practice. Participants explore vocational pathways while contributing to A Rocha's conservation and education programs.

Throughout the program, participants engage in learning sessions, daily shared practices, mentorship, and two retreats at A Rocha's Boreal Ecology Centre. Leadership development, ecological knowledge, and spiritual formation are integrated into the experience.

Position Summary

Working as part of a cohort, the **A Rocha Programs Assistant** supports the delivery of A Rocha Manitoba's conservation science, environmental education, and urban agriculture programs. Assistants gain hands-on experience by supporting forest and bird monitoring at the Boreal Ecology Centre, facilitating environmental education activities for children, and participating in food-growing initiatives at A Rocha's community garden.

Through this role, assistants develop practical skills in conservation fieldwork, sustainable agriculture, and environmental education, as well as transferable skills in leadership, communication, teamwork, organization, and independent work.

- Participate in daily prayer, reflection, and group discussion
- Join learning sessions on ecology, agriculture, leadership, contemplative practices, and more
- Attend two retreats at the Boreal Ecology Centre (May & August)

- Comfortable working with children and in team settings
